The visual aids were especially helpful in highlighting the points of the presentation. Demonstrating the need to "hold onto values" while wresting the value towel let the students know that it will not always be easy to hang onto to what seems so sure in the beginning. Having the colored "negative influence" water stay colored until real stirring action took place was a clear way to say that you can't just *say* you are going to make changes, you have to actually *make* the changes.

Throughout the following weeks we have heard our students mention the assembly in a positive light and always to reiterate a point that was made during the assembly. We, as a school, took the points made during the assembly and incorporated them into our in-school television announcements during the following week. We are keeping the message alive and truly appreciate the organized and captivating way you presented the material.

Due to logistics, we had Grades 1 – 8 at the same assembly. The presenter was able to incorporate all age groups in the assembly and kept everyone's interest active. The message about the older children being good role models for the younger children certainly hit home.
